Skills developed: Sequencing, storytelling, summarizing

A great way for your child to develop comprehension skills is by retelling their favorite stories. Give your little performer a chance to shine while practicing summarizing!

Things you'll need:

- One of your child's favorite books
- Audience members (stuffed animals, pets, family, or friends)

How to play:

Ask your child to choose a favorite book that they have read with you many times.

Have your child choose their audience: They can line up stuffed animals, bring pets into the room, or ask family members to watch.

Let your child take the stage and perform the main events in their favorite story. They can also reenact their favorite parts of the book!
