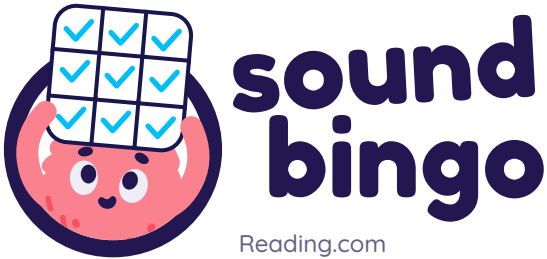


Sound Bingo Expansion Pack 3:  **Beginning Sounds** +  **Ending Sounds**

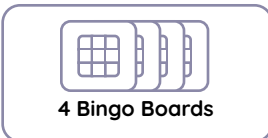

Expansion Pack Instructions

- 1.** Print out all pages. Cut out the new Sounds Bingo boards.
- 2.** Decide if you want to play Beginning Sounds Bingo or Ending Sounds Bingo. Make sure each player has the same type of board from the same letter set.
- 3.** Set up and play the game as you normally would by pulling a letter card, showing it to all players, and saying the **sound** that that letter makes. Make sure you clarify if players are looking for words with the same beginning sound or words with the same ending sound, depending on which boards you are using.

Important notes

- a)** Coins, dried pasta, or cereal pieces work well as bingo tokens
- b)** Use the provided key to know what each image is if you are unsure
- c)** The vowels in this game are all short sounds: A as in “apple,” O as in “otter,” E as in “egg,” I as in “igloo,” and U as in “umbrella.”
